Dear Year 10 and 11 Parent/Carer

I would like to invite you to an informal Parents' Evening on **Thursday 26th March 2026 at 5.00pm** in Hall 1, for about an hour, to discuss ways in which you can help and support your child through the forthcoming GCSE period.

We have drawn up a Revision Planner for our Key Stage 4 pupils which will take them from the beginning of the Easter holiday to the end of the GCSEs. It will help them organise their work and we will explain it to you on the night.
